

# Supplies List

## Elementary Art, Middle Grades Art and High School Art

### Required:

- Apron/Smock for Class \$2-\$6
  - Can be as simple as a big old T-shirt or button down from a thrift store.
  - There is the potential for clothes worn to art class to get dirty. Please be mindful of what you wear.
- Art Portfolio \$1-\$10
  - Can be as simple as a piece of posterboard stapled along the sides.
  - This will be used to collect the students artwork throughout the semester so they can choose their work at the end of the semester for the art show.
- Scotch Tape \$1-\$4
- Jar/Cup for Water Free-? :)
  - You can use an old cup or buy a special one just for art!
- 1.5" 3-Ring Binder \$3-\$7
  - Must have a clear cover and inside pockets.
- Mixed-Media Spiral Sketchbook \$5-\$10
  - 9"x12" is a good standard size
  - At least 60-70 sheets
- Hand-held Pencil Sharpener \$1-\$3
  - An electric sharpener is ok too.
- Black Sharpies \$2-\$5
  - Ultra-Fine Tip, Fine Tip, and Large (Pointed - Not chiseled)
- Plastic Eraser \$1
  - Staedtler Mars is a popular brand.
  - May be cheaper to buy a pack.
- Large Drawing Pad \$10
  - 14" x 17" or 18" x 24"
  - At least 30 sheets
- Colored Markers \$6-\$20
  - Wide and fine tips
  - Permanent and/or Washable
- Pan of Watercolors \$2-\$6
  - I've used Artist's Loft from Michael's many times.
  - The more color variety the better!
  - Synthetic Watercolor/Paint Brushes \$5-\$12
  - Nylon or Polyester
  - Variety of sizes and tips (small, medium, pointy, and flat)
  - Size Range: 2-8
  - Buying a set will be more cost-effective

- Set colored chalk pastels \$6-\$12
  - 12 ct. - 24 ct.
  - Make sure there is a black in your set!
- Glue Stick(s) \$4
  - Elmer's disappearing purple glue sticks are great!
  - You can split a pack between siblings or friends.
- Colored Pencils \$1-\$20
  - 12 ct. - 24 ct.
  - Any brand from Crayola to Prismacolors will work.
- Oil Pastels \$4-\$6
  - Set of 12-16
  - CRAY-PAS is a great starter brand!
- Scissors \$2-\$4
  - Big kid or adult-sized

### Optional:

*This will also give you a sneak peek into some things we will be getting into this year!*

- Drawing and Shading Pencils \$2 a pencil, \$4-\$10 for a set.
  - 5B, 6B or Ebony, HB, 2H or 4H
  - Buying a set may be more affordable and include an eraser.
- Small set of Acrylic Paint \$6-\$12
  - You can get a small set of many colors for around \$8 at some craft stores!
  - Shop around and see what exciting options there are!
- Canvases \$1-\$20
  - JoAnn's frequently has sales on canvases.
  - Anything larger than 24" x 36" will more than likely exceed \$20.
- Black Pilot Pens \$3 a pen
  - V7 or V5
  - You can find these at Office Depot or Staples.
- Black Flair Felt Tip Pens \$3 a pen
  - Paper Mate brand
  - You can find at Office Depot or Staples
- Colored Gel Pens \$10-\$15
- Charcoal \$3 (vine) and \$2-\$4 (compressed)
  - Vine and/or Compressed
- Multi-Colored Conté Crayons \$3-\$16
  - 4 ct. - 12 ct.
- Multi-Colored Paper Pad \$4-\$7
  - NOT construction paper
  - May be labeled as sulphite paper
  - Fadeless Art Paper has various colors and can be used with different media.
- Multi-Colored Construction Paper Pad \$3-\$6

- Assortment of Paint Pens \$5-\$15
  - Fine Tip and/or Medium Tip
  - Sharpie is a popular brand.
- Large Synthetic Watercolor/Paint Brushes \$6+ per brush
  - Nylon or Polyester
  - Round and Flat
  - Size Range 9-16
- Air Dry Clay \$7-\$8 (5 lb. box)
  - Grey and/or Terra Cotta
- Baby Wipes \$1-\$3
  - Good for cleaning surfaces and hands!
- Various Fabrics \$ Various
  - Most fabric stores have clearance fabric aisles and/or “fat quarters” you can buy.
- Felt 50¢ per sheet; \$12 per multi-colored bundle
- Fibers (Yarn, Jute, Twine, etc.) \$ Various
  - There are many discount websites.
  - Many fabric stores have discount bins or aisles.
- Cardboard \$ FREE
  - Many stores recycle cardboard. If you ask them about free cardboard, they will typically let you have as much as you want if you load it into your vehicle.
- Hot Glue Gun \$2-\$10
- Package of Hot Glue Sticks \$1-\$6
  - I like to use the 10 in. glue sticks. Less reloading and they’re just plain cool.
